RESOLUTION NO. 035- 2026

RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE DRY-RUN ON THE PROPOSED IMPLEMENTATION OF ONE-WAY STREET, NO PARKING, AND TRUCK BAN ON CERTAIN STREETS WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF BARANGAY TIZA AND BARANGAY LAWAAN, ROXAS CITY, TO BE CONDUCTED BY THE TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT UNIT FROM FEBRUARY 24, 2026 TO APRIL 24, 2026.

WHEREAS, the Barangay Council of Barangay Tiza submitted to this august body their proposed changes of routes in several streets within the jurisdiction of Barangay Tiza to address the traffic congestion by the commuters and riding public;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Roxas City, through the Committee on Police, Fire and Peace and Order Conduct a committee meeting and a result of which recommend to have a dry-run on the proposed traffic scheme in order to aid the Barangay, Traffic Management Unit and Sangguniang Panlungsod of Roxas City to determine the effectiveness of the said traffic scheme to address our traffic problems;

WHEREAS, after thorough study and deliberation, the Committee on Police, Fire, and Peace & Order and the Traffic Management Unit found the proposal of the Barangay Council of Barangay Tiza is with merit and sensible, and deemed it proper to extend the dry-run on its implementation prior to the enactment until the ordinance be passed;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion presented by Hon. Fernando Luis A. Viterbo Unanimously seconded it was,

RESOLVED, as the Committee on Police, Fire, and Peace & Order hereby authorizes, the Roxas City Traffic Management Unit to extend the dry-run for two (2) months on the proposed traffic scheme within the territorial jurisdiction of Barangay Tiza and Barangay Lawa-an, Roxas City by the Traffic Management Unit from February 24, 2026 to April 24, 2026 as follows:

1. ONE WAY

- a. ATIENZA STREET– one way heading southwest from its entry at Camansi Street up to Hemingway Street;
- b. CAMANSI EXTENSION – one way heading northeast from its entry at Hemingway Street up to the rear wall of the Villareal Stadium at Camansi Street;

2. NO PARKING


- c. No parking on BOTH SIDES of Camansi Street;
- d. No parking on BOTH SIDES of Datiles Street;
- e. No parking on BOTH SIDES of Tumanon Street;
- f. No parking on BOTH SIDES Hemingway Street (Corner Fuentes Drive up to Block 6);
- g. No parking on BOTH SIDES all of Block 6;
- h. No parking on East Side of Atienza Street from the corner of Camansi Street to Hemingway;
- i. No parking on West Side of Camansi Extension;

3. TRUCK BAN


- j. All vehicles weighing 5 tons and above, and all 10-wheeler trucks shall be prohibited from traversing the length of Block No. 6 from its Eastern end at Hemingway Street to its Western end at Lawaan Highway;

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Traffic Management Unit is hereby authorized to implement the proposed traffic scheme embodied in this Resolution.
